

Nebraska Conference Youth Event Covenant

A covenant is an agreement between members of a community. When the Covenant is not followed, all members experience brokenness. This covenant has been established by Youth Common Table to help the community be aware of the expectations set forth here so that the community may remain a whole.

1. You are required to attend all scheduled activities.
2. Only those registered for the event are allowed at community activities.
3. Due to liability issues all youth must turn in their car keys at registration.
4. You are not allowed in the living areas of the opposite sex.
5. Be in your bed at lights out.
6. Possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or weapons is strictly prohibited.
7. Respect the facilities. Any property damage is your responsibility.
8. Name tags are to be worn at all times.
9. You are responsible for your belongings. Leave valuables at home.
10. If you need to leave for any reason, the appropriate person (i.e. youth director) must know prior to the event.
11. PDA as defined by the adults/Youth Leadership Team is not allowed.
12. Treat others how Jesus would treat them.

Failure to follow this covenant will result in appropriate disciplinary action as determined by the Youth Leadership Team and the adults present.
